"industry-focused education ... at project sites both in the US and abroad"





Application Requirements

- Requirements
 - Undergraduate Senior (Minimum cumulative GPA: 3.0)
 - Construction Management Primary or Secondary
 - Desire to work in Construction Management
 - Interview w/ Director & Meet the GLCM students
- Preferred Qualifications
 - Recommended GPA: 3.3+
 - Cumulative, CEE, CM, Last 60 credits
 - Construction Management Internship Experience
- After GLCM Selection
 - Letter of recommendation from industry professional AND CEE professor


